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



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# SHELTER PROGRAM

*[New IDPs were distributed with winterization kits / Almile camp in Marib GOV]*



The project is supposed to target 700 HHs from Alkhaniq camp with winterization kits, but after the events that occurred and due to the displacement of Alkhaniq's IDPs and dispersed to different areas, IOM increased the number of those targeted by the winterization kits to 1400 HHs and add 1,000 HHs with SNFIs.

**Distribution of 700 winterization kits to New IDPs to Conflict Affected Displaced Populations in Mazjar, Sarwah and Madghal districts:**

YDN coordinated with IOM and the Executive Unit on tracking New IDPs from Mazjar . 280 new IDPs were tracked in Alswyda camp and 93 in Almile camp. Those were distributed by YDN with winterization kits.

As for the rest of the first 700 winterization kits were distributed to Mazjar and Alkhaniq IDPs in Marib city.



The other 700 winterization kits are planned to distribute with the same targets of SNFIs, as it is planned to be covered by the entire Madghel district, except for the Alkhryta and Alsalam camps, which is targeted by BCHR. Also, SNFIs will be targeted to the IDPs who were targeted with RRM kits in Sarwah. And to Mazjar district if the situation calmed down, or if it did not they will be targeted only with winterization kits and NFIs.

# HEALTH & NUTRITION PROGRAM

*[Field visit by project manager and MEAL manager to the mobile team in IDPs Huth Settlements – Amran governorate]*



YDN is currently supporting 1 district hospital (DH) and 1 medical mobile team (MMT) in Amran governorate and 3 HFs in Milhan district in Al-Mahwait governorate with health and nutrition services, as part of the “integrated health, nutrition and WaSH project” funded by YHF.

The project provides services primary and secondary health care, and nutrition services including both treatment and prevention services.

A total of 10,633 people were reached with health services that include IMCI, reproductive health care and consultations, and 2596 people reached with nutrition services including treatment and prevention services.

## **Training course for health workers on community management for acute malnutrition (CMAM)**

One training course (Basic) was conducted in Sana'a governorate. The training targeted 15 health workers who were nominated from Governorate Health Offices (9 HWs were selected and nominated from targeted HFs while 7 HWs were selected from other health facilities who have not been trained on CMAM at all in targeted districts). The training course was carried out in ten days, as planned in the reference of MoPHP. The aims of the course were to build the capacity and awareness of the HWs to achieve the CMAM program goal which is reducing the mortality and maternal mortality rates from acute malnutrition by providing timely diagnosis and effective treatment of acute malnutrition, and through building local capacity (health system and community) in the identification and management of acute malnutrition, discussing the difficulties and showing the reports.

The course was conducted successfully in the presence of GHO, DHO and close supervision of MoPHP.

## Training course for community health volunteers (CHVs) on MUAC and C4D.

The community health volunteers in the targeted areas were selected. The selection process has included several steps in receiving the requests, interviewing the applicants, and getting the requested consents and approvals. This was done by a team from both the health offices in the district and governorate level and the project team.

The basic training was targeting the selected CHVs in Milhan district, This course was implemented in Al-Mahwait city for nine days in the period from December 29th, 2019 to January 6th, 2020, in which 20 girls have been selected to be new CHVs as there were no CHVs in targeted areas. 19 girls out of 20 girls (one of the girls didn't attend the training) attended the training course to learn various health aspects, terms and measurements in order to be qualified to work efficiently in the field. Two trainers were sent from GHO & DHO and a third central supervisor was sent from MoPHP in Sana'a to ensure the high level of information conduction and professional skills training. During the nine-day training, the CHVs learned a lot about nutrition, nutrients, pregnant feeding, infant and young children feeding, MUAC values for children and PLW, malnutrition types, causes and treatment and how to perform the various related measurements and conduct the health messages to the community around.

# EDUCATION PROGRAM



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An activity in education was carried out by encouraging students to continue their education. To prepare for an activity to provide water reservoirs for three schools and provide water for one year of schooling by knowing RP, communicating with education offices to determine the most need GAPS, focusing on major schools within the secretariat, and restricting education and work on obtaining a permit to start. The 4W report was submitted to the National Clusters concerning the closure of the 20,000 school kits distribution project in 4 southern governors.
